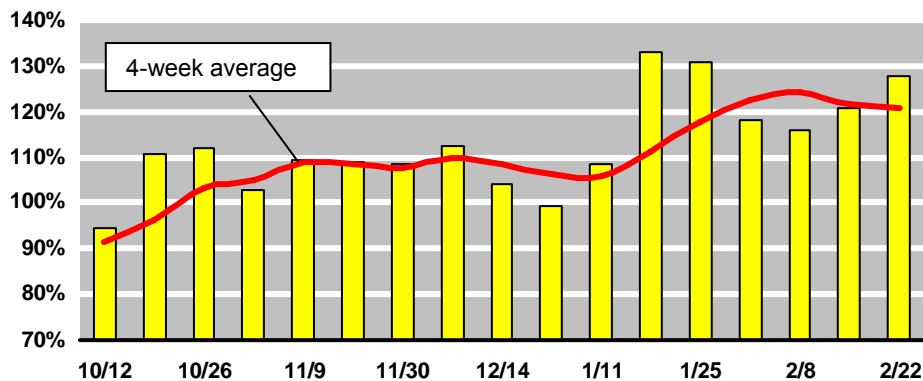

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* closed out the school week with a reading of 127 points, up +6.8 points from the preceding week. This means that as a group, Dr. Choice's weekly performance indicators managed to reach 127% of their goals (chart below).

**Percent-of-goal achieved, 16 weekly indicators**



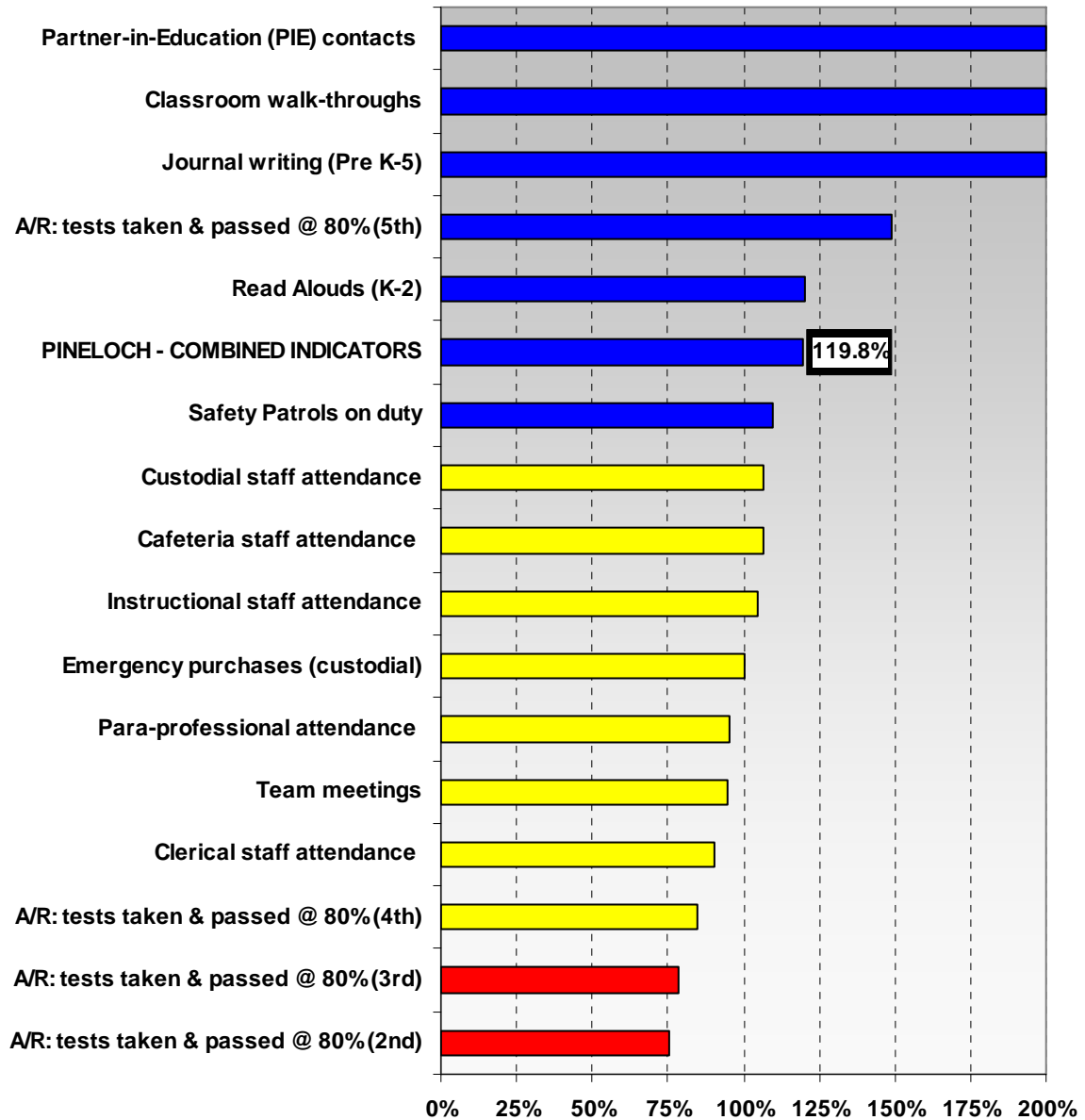
## SHORT WEEK

Due to the Presidents' Day holiday, certain Pineloch indicators had to have their indexes adjusted this week. This was done in that the school's goals are based on the traditional five-day school week. Therefore, certain indexes may appear a bit overstated at first glance.

As the chart above reveals, this was the 3<sup>rd</sup> best overall week of 2007-08. This week: 1) six indicators improved in terms of their actual results vs. goal when compared to the prior week; 2) four slipped back; and 3) six went unchanged. With the exception of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, all grades experienced gains with their *Accelerated Reader activity*. In fact, the 4<sup>th</sup> grade improved their percent-of-weekly goal achieved to 127.5% on the week, up from 82% a week earlier...a gain of +45.5%!

The leadership team did their part this week. Both *the number of classroom walk-throughs* as well as the number of *contacts made to various Partners-in-Education* exceeded goal. As the chart on the next page illustrates, both of these key measures are running at  $\geq 200\%$  of goal over the past four reporting periods.

## How Things Stand Now: Past Four Weeks (Percent-of-goal achieved)



How to read the chart: The chart is read as the percent-of-goal achieved for each one of the school's short-run performance indicators as well as for the combined group. The reason that progress over the past four weeks is spotlighted here is that the majority of the annual FCAT testing process is now within range (March 11). Results over recent weeks prove a better indicator of current efforts and focus than those from earlier this past fall.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
