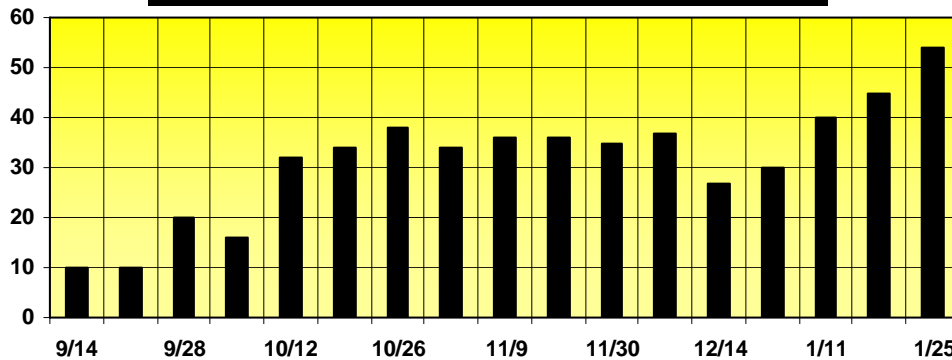

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* closed the week with a reading of 130.9 points. This means that the school's 16 weekly indicators combined to average 130.9% of their goals. As Dr. Choice just raised Pineloch's five-day goals in December and this was a short school week (Dr. King Jr.), this is once again a superior overall effort by the students and staff.

SHORT WEEK

As a reminder, Pineloch Elementary's weekly targets are based on the traditional five-day school week. In that this week was abbreviated due to the Dr. King Jr. holiday, certain indicators had to have their indexes adjusted. This is why on the surface certain indicators may appear to be overstated (e.g. *Partner-in-Education contacts made*).

When compared to the prior school week: 1) three measures improved relative to their weekly goals; 2) three retreated; and 3) ten were unchanged. The biggest mover on the week was the *custodial team's attendance rate* rising to 95% from 90% in the preceding week. On a 2007-08 school year-to-date basis, the custodial team has averaged 95.7% attendance on a weekly goal set to 95.0% per week...well done.

As far as the weakest indicator this week, that would be the number of *3rd grade Accelerated Reader tests taken and passed at the 80% level*. Even after adjusting for one less student day, this *Student Achievement* measurement came in at the 72.3% vs. goal...considerably off target (please see table on the next page).

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
