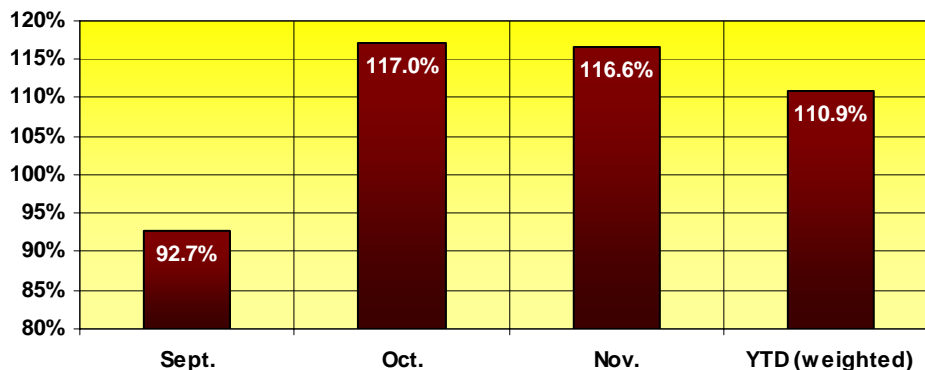

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* advanced 6.8 points to 122.6 in the week ended November 30, as all 16 of the school's weekly indicators achieved 94% of goal or better. This means that as a group, these short-range success measures *collectively* achieved 122.6% of their goals.

NOVEMBER

The nearby chart illustrates actual results vs. goal for the school's 16 weekly performance indicators as a group. This month they averaged 116.6% of plan. This is down just slightly from October's 117% result. What should be of particular interest is the fact that none (zero) fell outside of the "yellow zone" shown in the table on the next page. This indicates that all of Pineloch's short-range measures attained 85% of goal or better for a typical November week. This is truly remarkable given the number of indicators the school monitors every five days.

Four of the weekly measures exceeded plan by +10% or more. These have their "indexes" shaded in blue: 1) *2nd grade Accelerated Reader activity*; 2) *K-2 Read Alouds*; 3) *Classroom walk-throughs by the leadership team*; and 4) *Partner-in-Education weekly contacts*.

Headed into December, the only remaining areas of opportunity (actual results vs. goal) would be working to keep up the progress now being made using the *Accelerated Reader* program for grades 3, 4, and 5. The cumulative school year-to-date indexes here are shaded in red indicating that since early September they are still running at less than 85% of plan. However, over recent weeks, the trend has certainly changed!
