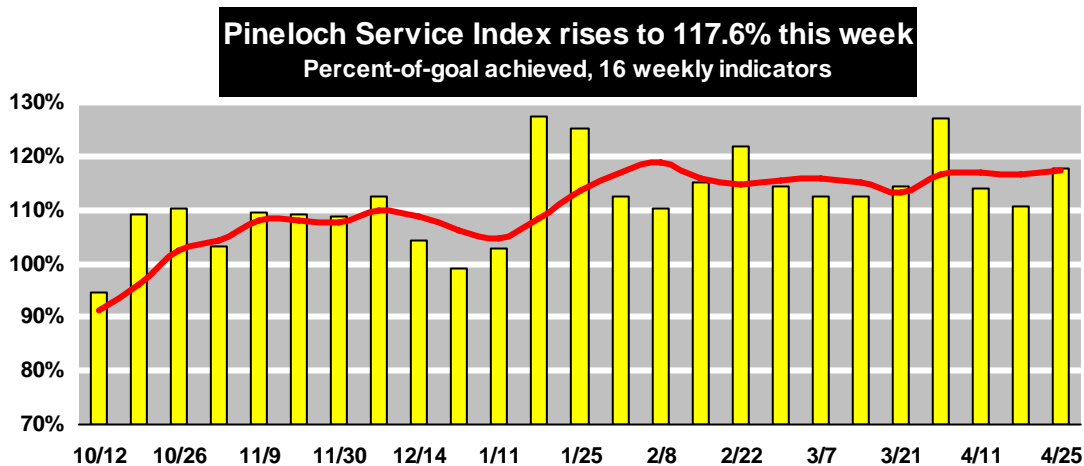

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* closed out the school week at the 117.6 level on Friday, up from 110.5 in the prior week. This means that as a group, Dr. Choice's weekly performance indicators managed to reach 117.6% of their weekly goals.



FIVE DAYS

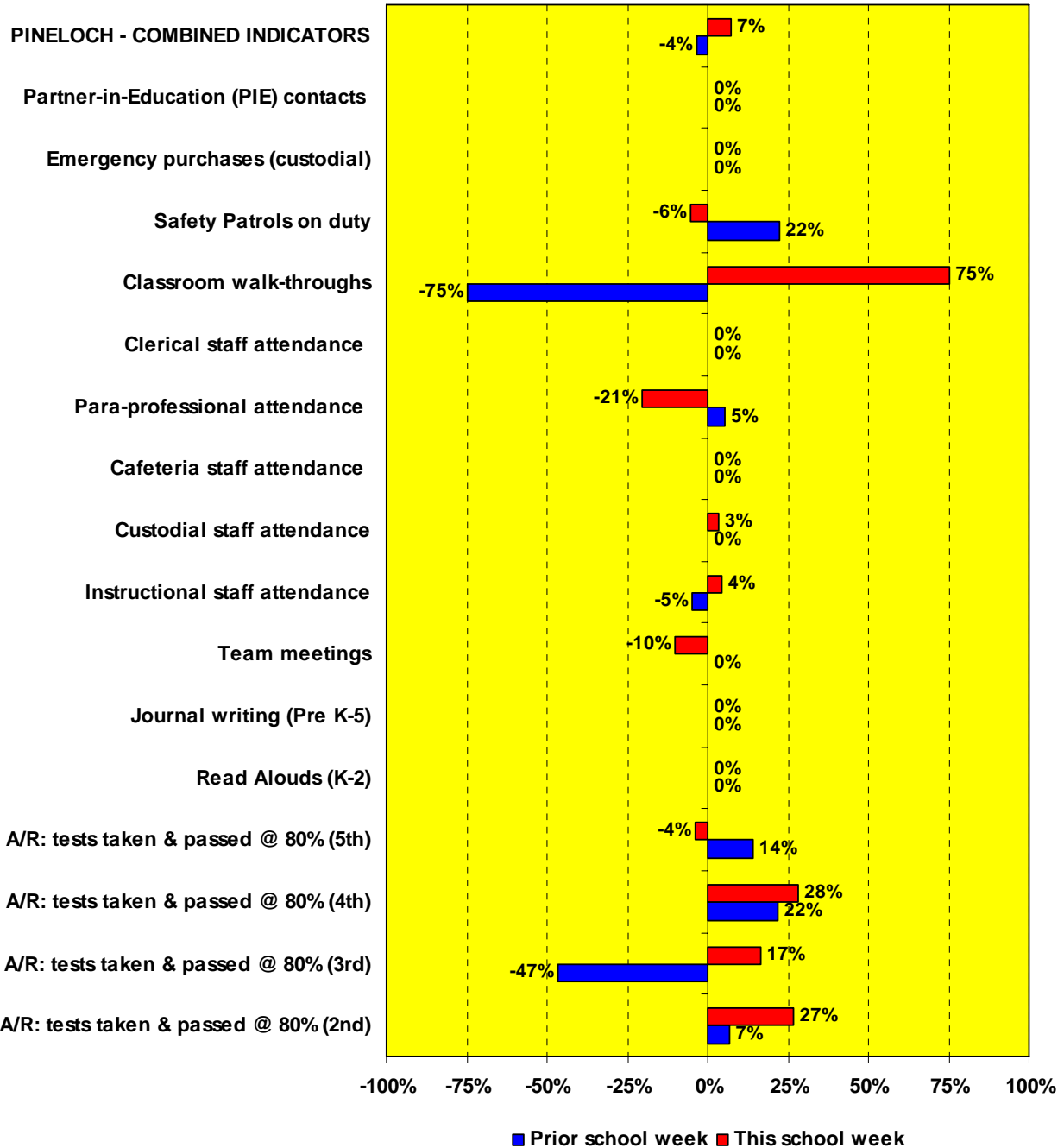
This past week was the 29th reporting week of SY 2007-08. After 29 reporting periods, the elementary school has attained 109.9% of plan with three weekly indicators still performing at less than the desired 85% threshold (*Accelerated Reader* test results).

As Mrs. Dawson correctly mentioned in her weekly notes, *Accelerated Reader* activity bounced back this week. This is illustrated in the chart on page two. The bottom bars highlighted in red reflect gains or losses vs. the prior week. Three of four grades increased the number of students sitting for and passing ($\geq 80\%$) their *Accelerated Reader* tests. While the 3rd grade did not attain 85% of their weekly goal, they still improved vs. the prior week.

There were 53 classroom walk-throughs reported this week on a goal of 20 per week. The net effect of such high volume in only five school days was to bring the four-week moving average to 45 class visits per week...better than 2X goal. Excellent.

What Changed: Week-over-Week Effort

How to read the chart: The percentages in the chart above are interpreted as the percent-of-goal either improved or lost when the latest week is contrasted with the preceding school week. The results in this fashion are displayed for the past two reporting periods courtesy of Mrs. Tammy Dawson. As an example, this week 4th grade Accelerated Reader activity rose this week to 45 students from 31 students in the prior week on a goal of 50 per week per Dr. Choice. Forty-five students over a 50 student target is 90% goal attainment for this week vs. 62% of goal in the prior week. The difference in these two values is +28%...the figure appearing next to the red bar in the chart. An impressive week-over-week gain.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
