

# Weekly Service Review

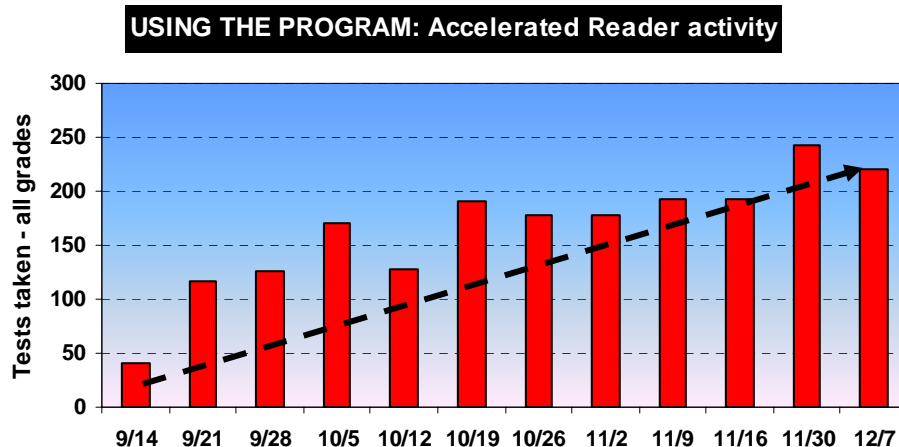

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* slipped -3.6 points this week driven back by fewer students participating in the *Accelerated Reader (A/R)* program. However, as the chart below offers, this has been a strong area for Pineloch Elementary over time. The *Pineloch Service Index* closed with a reading of 119.0 meaning that overall, the school's short-run performance indicators collectively averaged 119% of plan...a very good weekly result.



## FIVE DAYS

This was the second consecutive week that all of the school's weekly indicators achieved at least 85% of their weekly goals. This is why all of the *indexes* in the weekly column (Dec. 7) within the table appear in either yellow or blue. This is not an easy task given a total of 16 measures that are monitored every five days.

This was also the 9<sup>th</sup> week in a row that Pineloch Elementary finished in the triple digits...all 16 short-run performance indicators averaging 100% or better as a group. With the end of 2007 near by just two school weeks, this is a significant statistic. The only area "coming up short" this late in the year has been A/R, but as the chart notes this is being remedied by the teaching team.

If there was an area of opportunity in the week ahead it would be with the *safety patrols on duty*. This result has now slipped from a perfect 100% three weeks ago to 92% for this past week. Otherwise, an excellent week and a tip of the hat to the staff for making it so...the figures on page two speak for themselves.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Anderson established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Edgewater's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (yellow zone).
