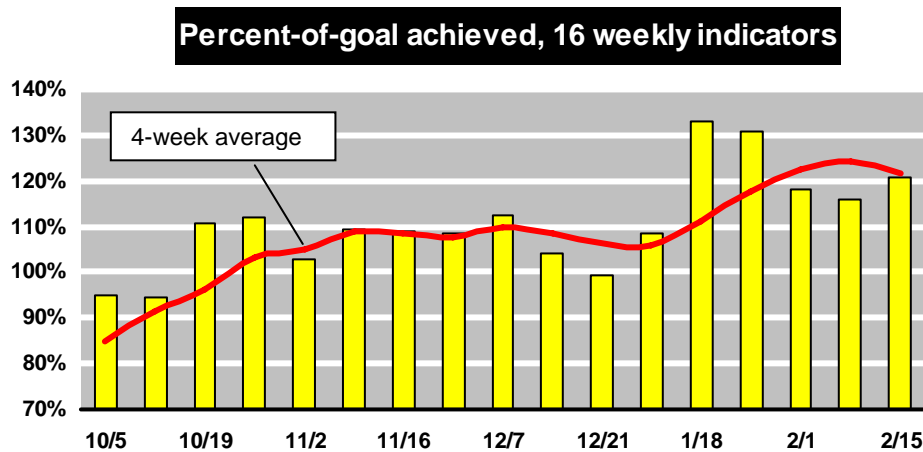

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* improved +4.9 points this week closing with a reading of 120.8 on Friday. This means that on a combined basis, the school's 16 short-range service measures managed to achieve 120.8% of their goals (immediate chart).

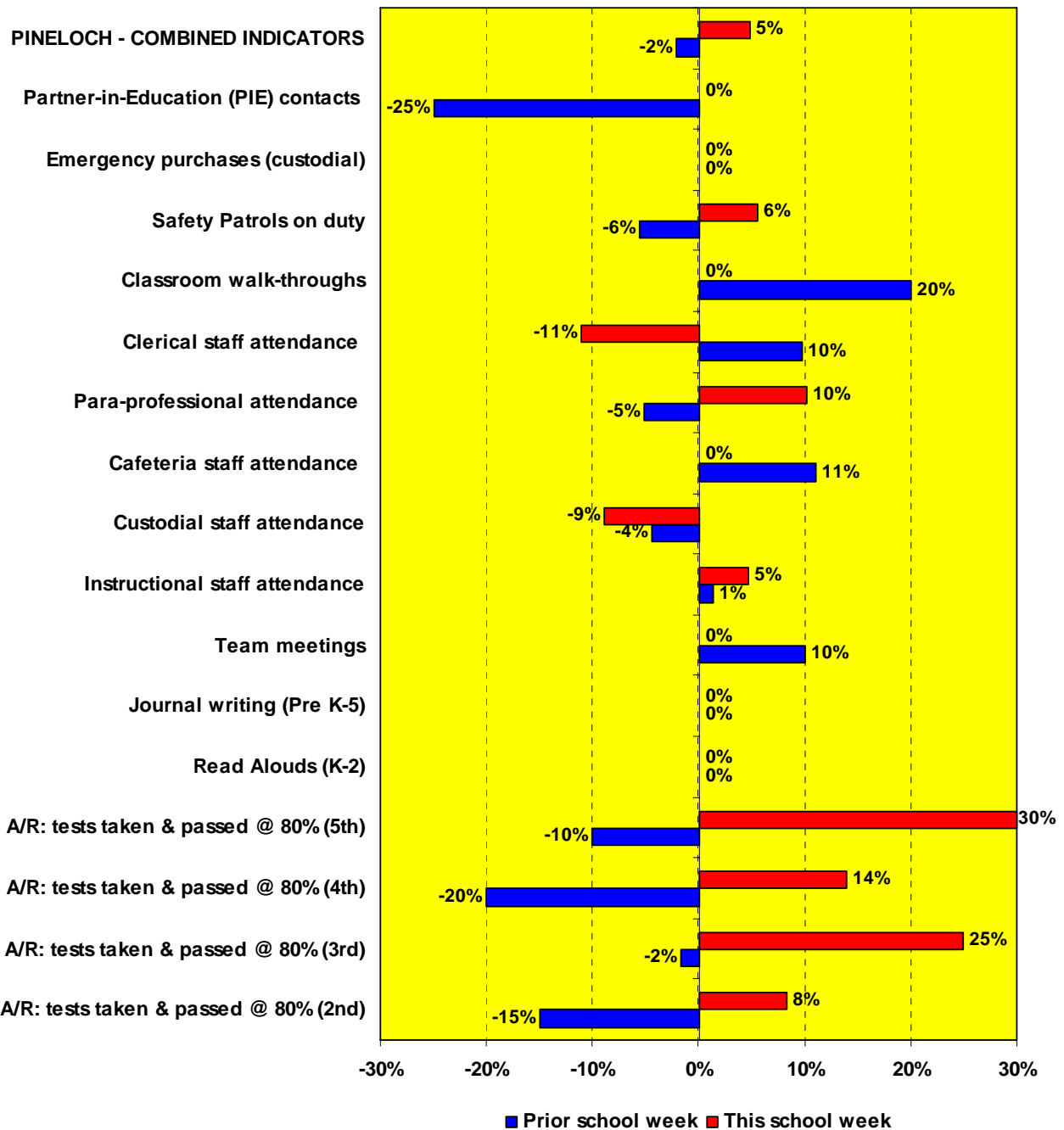
As the chart above provides, overall results-to-date at Pineloch Elementary School have been quite strong for each week of 2008. In fact, over the past four weeks, the school has managed to average 118.9% of their collective goals.

There was only one Pineloch indicator that had a lower score in terms of actual results vs. goal both this past week and for the preceding week – *the custodial staff attendance rate*. This is why the red bar (this week) and the blue bar (the prior week) appear in a negative format to the left of the central axis on the next chart. (*The custodial staff attendance rate* dropped off to 88% for this past week from a perfect 100% two weeks ago.) Conversely, *the instructional staff attendance rate* has improved relative to a similar 90% goal over the past two reporting cycles. This explains why the red and blue bars on the same chart are positioned to the right of the central axis. (*The instructional staff attendance rate* reached 97.4% this week, up from 91.9% two weeks ago.)

The journal writing opportunity indicator deserves mention. This week was the 6th consecutive +200% of goal week...that is +200% for each school week of 2008. Tremendous.

What Changed: Week-over-Week Effort

Difference in the percent-of-goal achieved, 16 service measurements



How to read the chart: The percentages in the chart above are interpreted as the percent-of-goal either improved or lost when the latest week is contrasted with the preceding school week. The results in this fashion are displayed for the past two reporting periods courtesy of Mrs. Tammy Dawson. As an example, the *clerical staff attendance rate* dipped this week to 80% vs. 90% in the prior week on a goal of 90% per week per Dr. Choice. Eighty-percent (80%) is statistically 88.9% of the 90% weekly goal. Ninety-percent (90%) is equal to 100% of the same 90% weekly goal. The difference in these two values is -11.1%...the figure appearing in the chart.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
