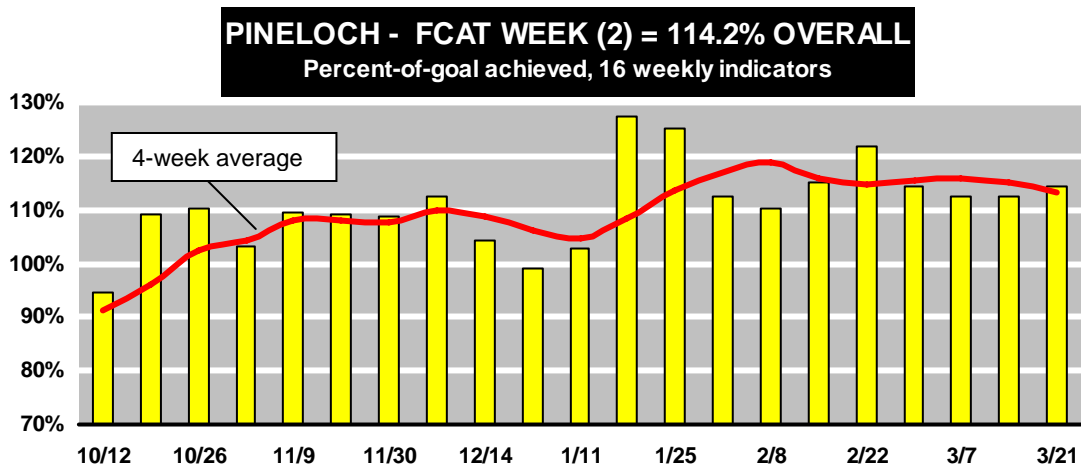

Pineloch Elementary School's *Weekly Service Index* closed out the school week at the 114.2 level on Friday. This means that as a group, Dr. Choice's weekly performance indicators managed to reach 114.2% of their weekly goals (chart below).



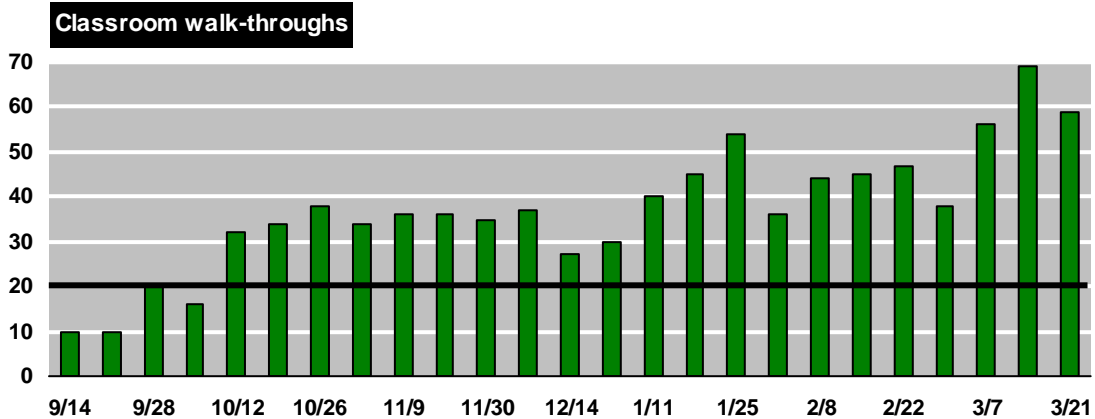
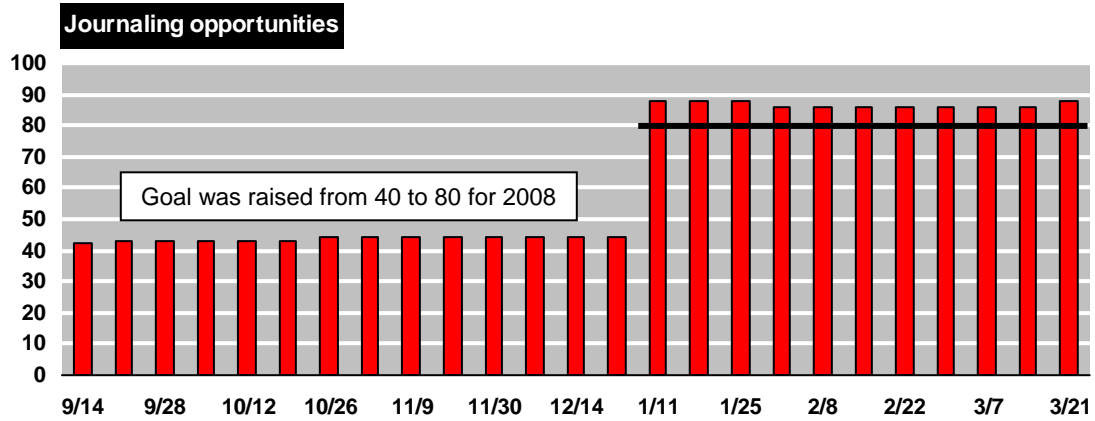
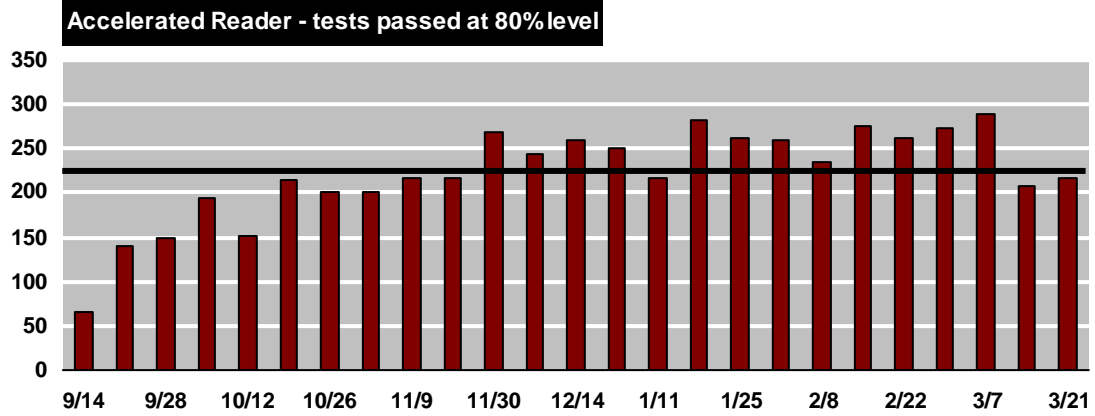
## FIVE DAYS – PART II FCAT (NRT)

This week was a continuation of the FCAT testing process with the Norm Referenced Testing element. Despite the time needed to administer the test, only two of the Pineloch's 16 weekly measures came in at less than 85% of their weekly goal: 1) *3<sup>rd</sup> grade Accelerated Reader tests taken and passed at the 80% level* and 2) *the number of team meetings held by the staff*. These could have easily been impacted by FCAT testing.

In terms of week-to-week progress: 1) six indicators improved with their actual results vs. goal; 2) five slipped backwards; and 3) five were unchanged. The biggest "mover" on the week was *the number of 4<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated Reader tests taken and passed at the 80% level* climbing to 43 from 34 during the FCAT testing. This was the 4<sup>th</sup> grade's 3<sup>rd</sup> best week so far of 2008. While still ahead of their goal this week, *the number of 5<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated Reader tests taken and passed at the 80% level* dropped to 73 from 79 making this measurement the one that slid back the most over five days.

Congratulations to the Cafeteria Staff – their 4<sup>th</sup> week of perfect 100% attendance! Well done.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
