

# Weekly Service Review

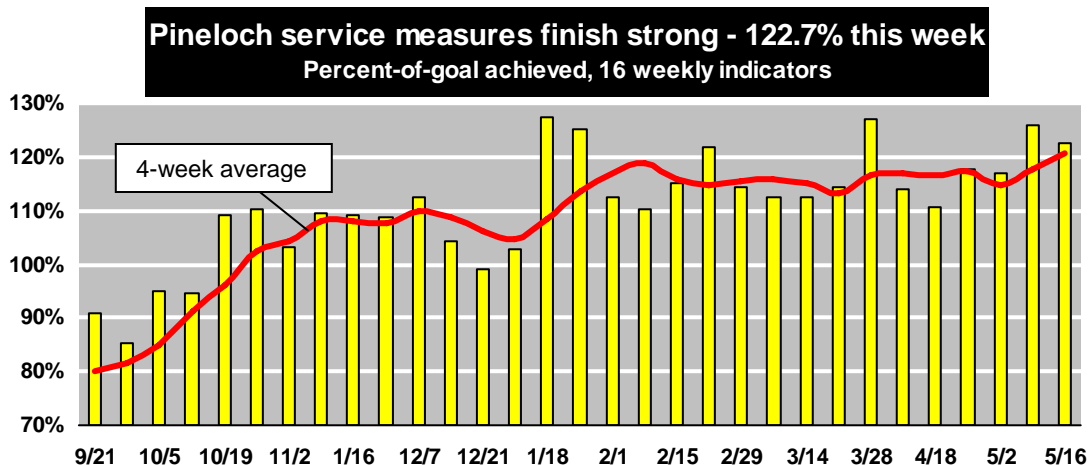

Pineloch Elementary School's weekly service indicators collectively attained 122.7% for the week. As the chart provides, overall performance has trended up since mid April.



## FIVE DAYS

In terms of actual results vs. goal: 1) three Pineloch indicators improved; 2) seven retreated; and 3) six were unchanged. The indicator that improved the most this week vs. goal was the number of team meetings rising from seven to nine meetings. The second place indicator this week was the number of classroom walk-throughs conducted by leadership (up from 37 to 42 this week).

The indicator that fell off the most for the week was *Accelerated Reader* activity. All four grades declined on the week led by a -34% drop off for the 4<sup>th</sup> grade. This is noteworthy in that the 4<sup>th</sup> grade is the only grade level that for SY 2007-08 is running at less than 85% of goal for *Accelerated Reader*. This is why their cumulative index is highlighted in red.

This week all five staff attendance categories exceeded the 90% weekly objective. In fact, both the cafeteria and clerical staffs had back-to-back 100% attendance weeks. Great effort!

Finally, thank you to Mrs. Woodruff who contacted 32 business partners for the *Young Author's Conference*. The event was a success and a number of partners did manage to attend.

How to read the table: The indexes are read as percent-of-goal achieved whereby 100.0 equals exact-to-goal. Principal Choice established these weekly measures last summer as method for tracking progress against the school's strategic goals during the year. If any indicator has its index shaded in red, then it is performing at less than 85% of goal for that time period. Over time, Pineloch's five-day service indicators should be falling inside the 85.0 to 110.0 range (shaded in yellow).
